1. Best Small Garden or Patio (residential garden under 5 metres)			
2. Best Large Garden or Patio (residential garden over 5 metres)			
3. Best Individual Planted Container (domestic hanging basket, trough, window box, pot or tub must be a <u>single</u> container)			
4. Best Unusual Individual Planted Container (Do you have an old tyre, welly boot, toilet or any discarded household item that can be used to create a stunning but unusual container)			
5. Best Commemorative Display (100th Anniversary of the end of WWI)			
6. Best Community Group Garden (entry must be maintained by volunteers and can be a garden, flower/veg bed, planted area or container)			
7. Best Schoolchildren's Garden - (1) Pre-school (2) School (must be mainly planted and maintained by the children)			
8. Best Neighbourhood Area (either a communal garden or the front gardens in an entire neighbourhood, road or a selection of properties within)			
9. Best Residential/Retirement Home Garden (entry must be maintained by the residents and can include a communal garden, a selection of individual entries within the home or an individual entry from one of the residents)			
10. Best Commercial Building (e.g. pub, restaurant or local attraction . The entry must be visible/open to the public and may be anything from an entire garden to a hanging basket)			
NEW Best Shop Window Display (does not need to include real plants)
