Alton Town Council & EHDC need to invest in town centre which is rapidly deteriorating in terms of look and feel of the place, scope of shops to attract public, facilities for local eating out/entertainment, parking and state of roads and walkways. This needed prior to house increases to attract people to use town centre.
19. Pedestrian/pavement improvements for new residents of development beyond Butts Green (Selborne Park?) and improved traffic management/signage at this entrance to the turn as still too many driving too fast.
20. More housing where, already there is pressure on: schools, doctor surgeries, free space/safe spaces, volume of cars and parking.
21. Need for Alton Council to sponsor a flood action plan (climate change assesses the risk annually).
22. Lack of engagement with businesses in town – not just town centre. No support for increasing footfall other than Jane Austen link which is actually Chawton!
23. The Kings Arms is overstepping its remit. Quizzing minors about their sexual activities is different to support.
24. Please don't build on school playing fields to add extra classrooms. The space is needed for sport/play/learning – it is not a lovely 'extra'. It's fundamental to our children's development.
