Health and Wellbeing

1. Have to support general practice better.
2. I am very concerned about the pressure on doctor, surgeries etc. Two practice still after 20 years and much more thought into needed to increasing. Doctors per head - thousands.
3. It is already impossible to be seen at the Wilson practice. Doctors additional residents makes this problem worse.
4. ALTON has expanded on all four corners with vast housing estates and now the middle is growing to the list. Has there been any expansion of GP surgeries, dentist another health facilities to go with it, NO - get this sorted first before more housing.
5. Please think carefully and retain the Chawton Park public community hospital campus for healthcare use.
6. Bentley surgery closed in February 2022 so the supply are not sufficient GP surgeries to cover the existing population of Holybourne. What is in place to mitigate the effects of another 2400 people if planning 1200 houses extra?
7. GP surgeries, cover, mental health and older persons car already overstretch services.
8. The other GP infrastructure around us is crumbling, see Bentley village surgery we took on 900 patients overnight. I was at my desk until late.
9. Chawton Park surgery, a marvellous space station in 2005 is now jam packed. Every available clinical space was occupied yesterday and also on many days, but we persist I'll be exhausted.
10. There are no doctors or nurses available now or for future in the population.
11. I have my voice to concerns already expressed about availability of healthcare essential to ensure a growing population equals improved about a bleak expanded healthcare as part of the development plan (not an afterthought).
12. GP is doing the jobs for which they are contracted and paid handsomely.
13. Not enough GP or dentist places as it stands.
14. Bring the Alton community hospital into the Hampshire, hospitals foundation trust so that they can be properly available at ALTON peoples, health issues and come under the auspices of ALTON GPs. The current situation is anomalous and ridiculous.
15. No availability of NHS dentists in the local area. Other towns are already putting pressure on Alton for this. I need to be included in the bigger picture GP appointments for also overstretched.
16. Health services struggling with capacity currently must be addressed to meet population growth.
17. Both of the surgeries are at maximum capacity. What will happen with more development? Cara Holmes has yet to be inhabited. How are they going to see a doctor?
18. Need more provision for mental health services, cancer patients and dementia homes. Also youth provision if adding large numbers of new dwellings.
19. Community facilities, doctors, dentist, pre-schools, etc are already under pressure and cannot cope with the current numbers.
20. Having just moved into Holybourne, the local dentist Ard already full for NHS treatment and I've had to go on a waiting list.
21. Wilson practice is a high quality medical facilities.
22. Insufficient doctors surgeries, infrastructure – Alton already has had huge recent development.
23. Current medical provisions clearly insufficient for existing residents/catchment area. More GPs medical facilities (physical and mental) required now but even more if resident numbers increase.
24. Gp surgeries – desperately need more after closure of Bentley. Wilson practice will no longer book appointments in advance.
25. My doctor tells me he starts work at about 5.30 most mornings to get through admin before he starts his day. They are amazing there but it is not sustainable. Are we attracting the older generations to Alton with all our lovely Mc.C Stone, can we really sustain this? More infrastructure required.
26. Lack of GP surgeries esp. after Bentley closed.
27. Inadequate Doctors Surgeries in Alton further aggravated by lots more new housing.
28. More houses but not enough doctors and dentists etc to cope with increased demand.
29. Another surgery. Have use of community hospital. More NHS dentists.
30. GPs are leaving the profession and retiring early.
31. The closure of Bentley GP surgery = 3000 people to Alton. Our surgeries can't cope with more influx. We have Cala Homes development and Ackender Hill to accommodate.
32. Holybourne proposed development. Are there enough GP places for the residents of 500+ more houses? Wilson GP practice is under real pressure due to the closure of Bentley Gp practice.
33. Bentley GP surgery has already closed, extremely hard to get a doctors appointment. How will Alton cope with more demands on GPs?
34. What about holiday meetings in schools to attract parents? Ask children to the college.
35. Lack of schools, doctors, general facilities already. How do we cope with growth? How do we make room for cyclists? How do we discourage cars?
36. Alton and Holybourne. Mental health is a concern. People live in smaller towns/villages to accommodate their mental health. Not everyone can live in a busy place.
37. All the GP practices are struggling with demand. There is no scope to expand.
38. Consider health provision. There is no more space for GPs or growth of surgeries.

50. Already impossible to get an appointment at the Wilson Practice. Really not looking forward to this future!
51. GP waiting time issues.
52. Very difficult to book a doctors appointment now. Stretched.
53. Mental health provision for school age students – years long waiting list will result in a time bomb situation. Help needed now.
54. Very hard to get doctor or dentist appointment. More people in the town will make it worse. Peoples health will suffer.
55. Consider health provision. Local practices do not have capacity to expand and there will not be a new one.
56. We really need another GP surgery especially with the ageing population.
57. Dedicated health hub.
58. Protection for health services especially Chawton Park Surgery, community hospital, Wilson Practice land.
59. General practice quality of service is terrible. Monies allocated to the NHS should be better spent not increased.
60. Greater use of Alton Community Hospital, wider range of diagnostic test and walk-in accident treatment centre (as in Petersfield).
61. Expansion of hospital services. Some cannot travel easy to larger towns.
