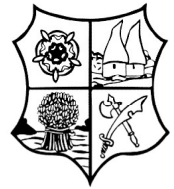

Please note that, while members of the public who are not on the Electoral Register may attend, only electors are able to vote on any motions (Local Government Act 1972, Sch 12, para 18(1)). There may be a delay to the start of the meeting while town council staff check the Electoral Register and issue voting cards to those eligible.

- 1 To elect a Chair for the purposes of the meeting if the Town Mayor or the Town Deputy Mayor is not in attendance (Local Government Act 1972, Sch 12, para 17)
2. Apologies received
3. Parish Poll
 - i: Purpose of the meeting.
 - ii: To discuss and pass a motion as to whether to move forward with a Parish Poll administered by East Hampshire District Council to advise Alton Town Council on public opinion in relation to King's Pond, noting that the outcome of a Parish Poll is non-binding. To demand a parish poll, the requisite number is 10 electors, or one-third of the electors present, whichever is the less (Local Government Act 1972, Sch 12, para 18(4)).
 - iii: If a poll is demanded, to agree the text of the question or questions to be put. This will be determined by a vote of the electors present at the meeting.
